In 2022 The Health and Care Act said that all Health and Care Professionals must have training on how to give Autistic People and People with Learning Disabilities good health care

Oliver sadly died, aged 18, in November 2016

The doctors and nurses treating Oliver had not had any training on how to work well with Autistic People and People with Learning Disabilities
